Black-headed Oriole

(Oriolus xanthornus)



The multifarious and diverse flora on the Chandbagh Estate attracts numerous birds. For those species that have made homes on the campus, there are rich pickings on offer - ranging from mango and leechi groves near Skinners to the safety of the bamboo thickets behind the Rosebowl, among the abundant foliage all around.

Our visitors come in different girths and plummage. You can spot the busy little Yellow-backed Sunbirds and Tree Pies on a regular walk, while the magnificent Golden Orioles and the Paradise Catcher will make a grand entry when you least expect it. Through the seasons, nature's bounty is on display. Their presence, however, does not go unnoticed. Come spring-summer, and you will be woken up by a wonderful cacophony of morning ragas while the monsoon mugginess is pierced by the echoing calls of the Asian Koels. Through the day, the Jungle Babblers do their fair share of attention seeking.

Among them, naturalist, author, filmmaker, avid photographer and a once upon a time artist Shiv Kunal Verma (182 H, 1976) has managed to 'capture' them in a series of drawings and watercolours. 
Indian Roller

(Coracias benghalensis)


